

Root Canal Coquitlam

A root canal is required whenever a nerve is being disrupted by infection or decay. Throughout a root canal therapy, the pulp or nerve core of the tooth, bacteria, nerves and decay are taken out. The resulting opening is then stuffed with special, medicated, dental materials, to allow the tooth to get back to its full functionality.

When a tooth dies and has to be extracted, oral health doctors typically advise patients to choose a root canal. Often, teeth extraction can be costly and you could have issues regarding the nearby teeth. Root canal therapies are extremely successful and generally last forever. Nevertheless on some occasions, a tooth could need to be retreated because of new infections.

Many of the signs and symptoms which may call for a root canal treatment include an abscess on the gums, amplified sensitivity to cold and hot stimulus, a severe toothache, and inflammation and soreness all-around the tooth.

In many cases there may be no symptoms evident. Other problems that could create a need for a root canal treatment include an infection or an abscess within the tooth, a corroded root pulp, or trauma or injury to the tooth.
