

Teeth Crowns Coquitlam

Crowns or "caps" are dental restorations that are customized, bio-compatible reinforcements that fit right overtop of a tooth or teeth. Often, dental crowns could be essential to cover up cracked fillings, chipped, broken, or sensitive teeth. Crowns can also be utilized cosmetically to enhance the appearance of stained, malpositioned, or malformed teeth.

Crowns are typically designed from durable ceramic materials and are particularly designed to blend naturally to your previously existing teeth, thus improving your overall smile. There are many situations that might suggest that you might require a crown, for example, a big filling that now is bigger than the actual tooth. The tooth anatomy has become too weak to support the filling. Other reasons you may require a crown is that there is widespread damage caused by tooth corrosion, discoloration, compromised aesthetics, and dental cracks. Moreover, following a root canal, teeth could become weak and brittle making them more prone to fissures or breakage. Crowns could be used to help protect damaged teeth. In addition, when patients are missing teeth on an arch they might use a tooth bridge, using the neighbouring teeth as foundation for the replacement teeth.

As well as delivering the needed stability and protection, crowns can also improve the aesthetic appeal of your teeth.
