A crown (or cap) is used to reinforce and protect the tooth's structure that can't be renewed with fillings or other varieties of dental fixtures. A crown is a covering that overlays the whole tooth's surface to return it to its previous size and shape.

There are several different kinds of tooth crowns, but porcelain (tooth-coloured) are really trendy thanks to their similarity to natural teeth. They are really resilient fixtures that can endure for years, however like most tooth restorations, they will need to be adjusted sporadically and may eventually have to be replaced. Created at a specialized dental lab, ceramic crowns are built to match the shape, dimensions, and colour of your existing teeth giving a long-term and beautifully organic smile.

Crowns may be used in conjunction to any number of these oral health issues like busted or cracked teeth, fractured fillings, huge fillings, aesthetic enhancement, or your tooth has just had an endodontic therapy.
